

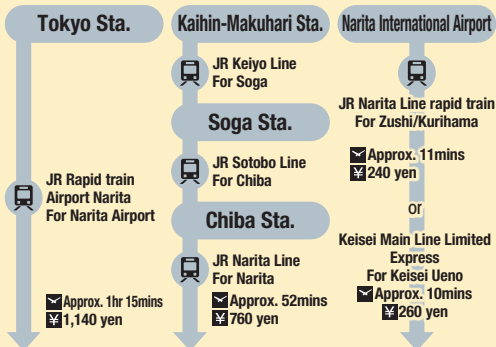
# H6 Walk the temple approach to invoke good luck ROUTE

A temple district a mere 10 minutes train ride from Narita International Airport. The approach all the way from the station to Naritasan Shinshoji Temple provides ample Japanese atmosphere, and the walk is enjoyable in and of itself. Narita-san Park located on the grounds is famous for its flowers. Plum and cherry blossoms, wisteria and chrysanthemums are among the flowers that can be seen throughout the seasons.
